Literacy

These are the phonemes we will be working on this month. Have a go at practising them at home. 😊



g

Spiral hand down, as if water going down the drain, and say *g, g, g*.



l

Pretend to lick a lollipop and say *l, l, l, l*.



f

Let hands gently come together as if toy fish deflating, and say *fffff*.



o

Pretend to turn light switch on and off and say *o, o, o, o*.



b

Pretend to hit a ball with a bat and say *b, b, b, b*.



u

Pretend to be putting up an umbrella and say *u, u, u, u*.


Harmony

Use the number line provided to reinforce before, after and in between.



Play I spy and find different 2d shapes (circle, square, rectangle & triangle) in the world around you.

Go for a walk and look for patterns in our world. Can you create a repeating pattern using items in your house or items from the outdoors?



Phonics

Write letters on pieces of paper and encourage your child to put them together to make a word by saying the word, breaking it up e.g. C-a-t, making the word, blending & then reading the word to you.
