In Primary 1, we encourage the children to have a go! Below are activities which your child could have a go, when at home this month.

Literacy

These are the phonemes we will be working on this month. Have a go at practising them at home. 😊



h

Hold hand in front of mouth panting *h, h, h* as if you are out of breath.



w

Blow on to open hand, as if you are the wind, and say *wh, wh, wh*.



j

Pretend to wobble on a plate and say *j, j, j*.



v

Pretend to be holding the steering wheel of a van and say *vvvvvvvv*.



y

Pretend to be eating a yoghurt and say *y, y, y*.



z

Put arms out at sides and pretend to be a bee, saying *zzzzzzzzzz*.

Numeracy

Encourage your child to count out to 30 and back.

Also, counting in 5s & 10s to 100.

This month we are starting to add on 0, 1 & 2 within 10 and for some within 20. Please see attached sheet for addition and subtraction game. Next month we will be starting subtraction.
