

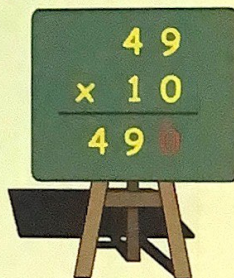
Multiplying by 10

It is easy to multiply a whole number by 10.

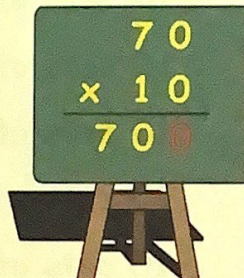
Simply, add a 0 to the **end** of the number

Example 1 49×10



Example 2 70×10

$$88 \times 10 = 880$$
