Spelling Rules: Adding TION



We add the suffix -tion to a word to make it into a noun. Often writers are confused as to when they should add -tion or -sion. We *usually* add -tion to a word when:

- 1) the word ends in -ate (vacate vacation)
- 2) Any word that ends in a consonant besides I, n, or r, especially those ending in t or -te (act action describe description)
