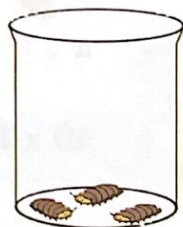

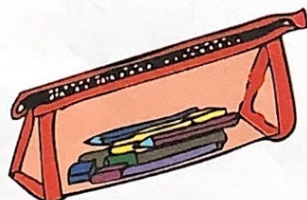
Flo's Flowers sold 430 bunches of roses on Valentine's Day.
