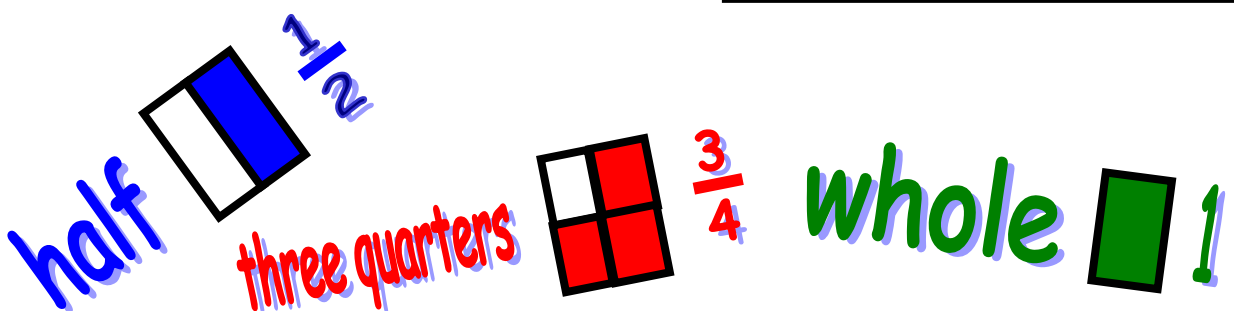
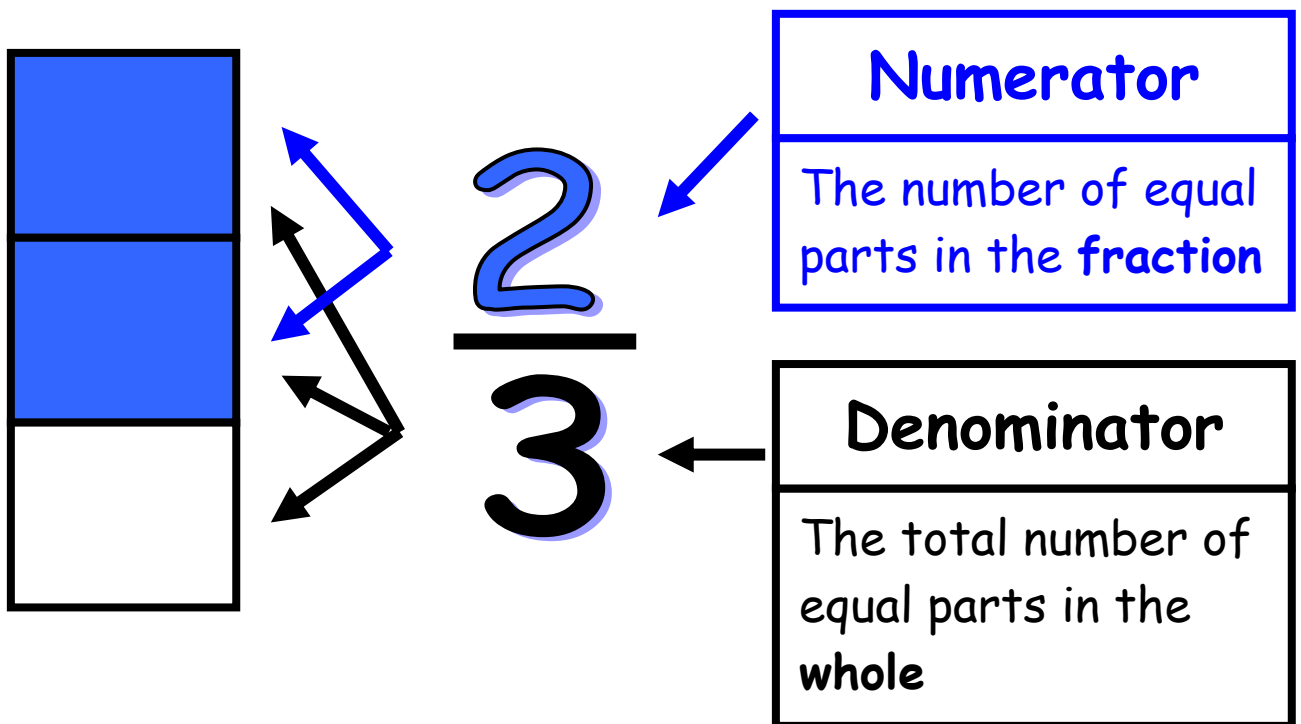
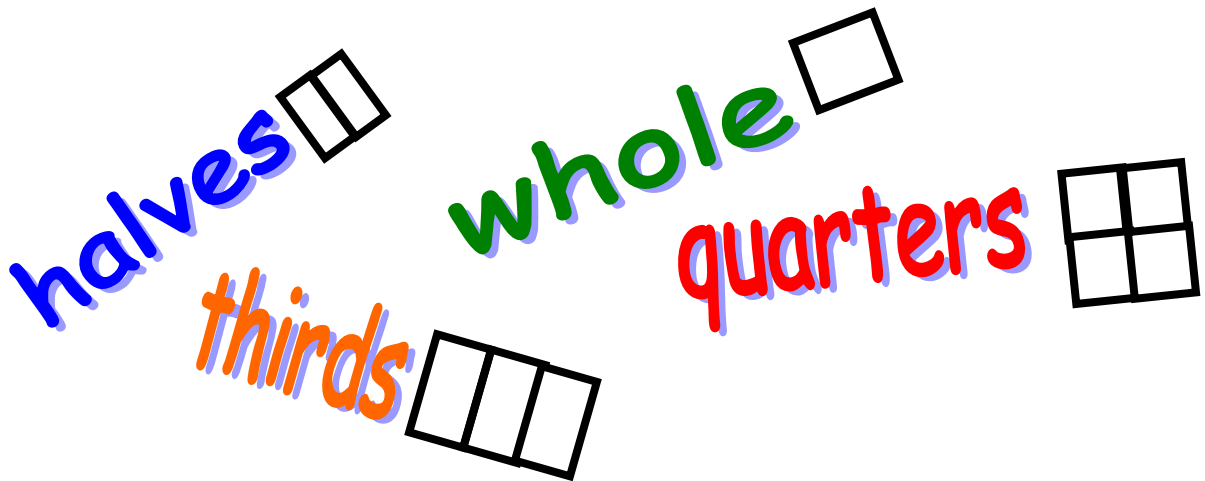


Fractions

What is a fraction?

A fraction is a whole split into equal parts.



Fractions

A unit fraction is when the numerator is equal to one.

For example:

$$\frac{1}{2} \quad \frac{1}{3} \quad \frac{1}{4} \quad \frac{1}{5}$$

A non-unit fraction is when the numerator equals more than 1.

For example:

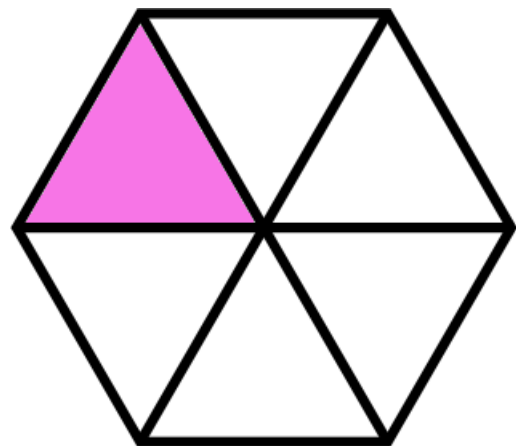
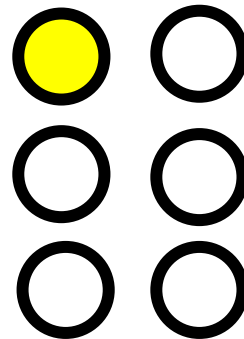
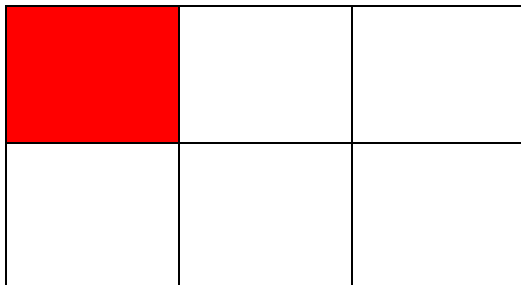
$$\frac{2}{3} \quad \frac{3}{8} \quad \frac{5}{6} \quad \frac{4}{5}$$

Different Ways of Representing a Fraction

There are lots of different ways to represent a fraction.

The following are all different ways to represent the fraction one sixth.



Each of the images above look different, but they all represent the same fraction.
