Write an acrostic poem entitled Endangered Animals.

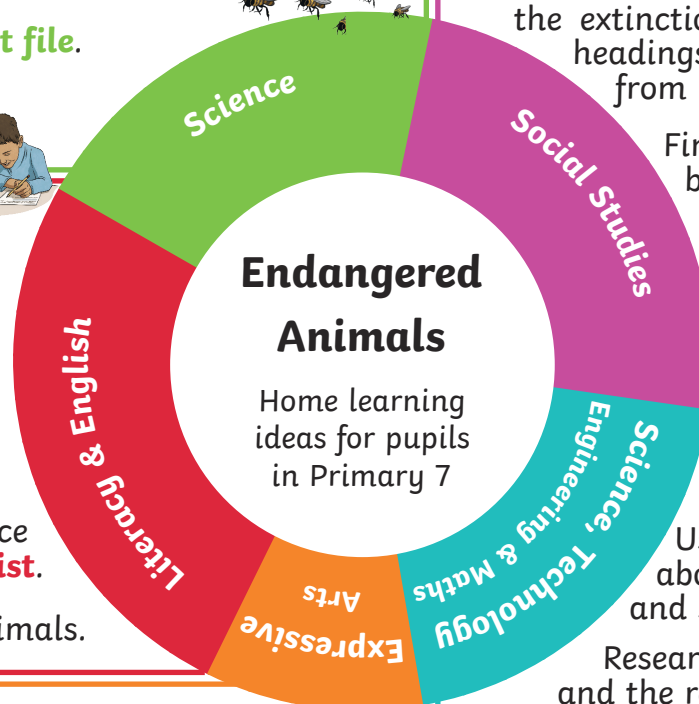
Research Endangered Species by Andy Warhol and share my thoughts about his work. Create my own piece based on his work.
