



## **Scottish Child Payment- Extended to children age under 16**

Social Security Scotland have **extended the age limit from under 6 years of age to under 16 year for Scottish Child Payment.**

**New claims can be made from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022** for children who will now fall into this extended age range.

Payment will also be **increased for each child to £25 per week.**

You can apply whether you're **in work or not**, as long as you're getting one or more of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Income Support
- Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)

**Please note you will need to re-apply for any children whom you previously received payment for, but this has now stopped. If you currently claim for children under 6 years old, you will need to add any older children under 16 years of age onto this claim.**
