Think of your favourite book character. Set a timer for five minutes and draw your character. See if someone else can work out who it is!

Report It

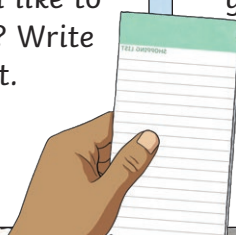
Imagine you are a reporter. Write a news report about a well-known book. Who is in the story? What happened? Where and how? Remember to include an attention grabbing heading.
