










## P3/4 Homework

#### Spelling

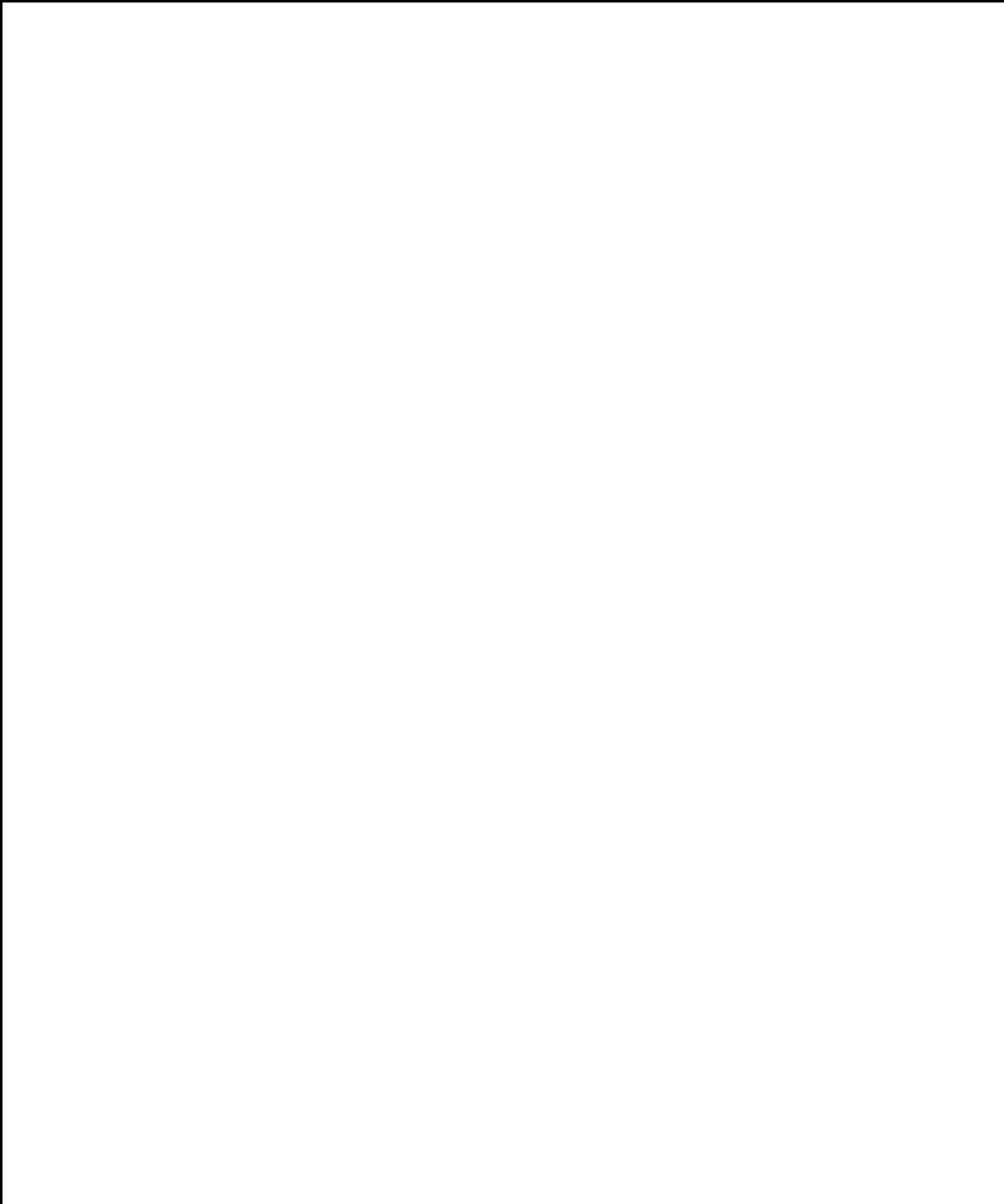

Using an old magazine, cut out the letters you need to make the words and glue them down on a new sheet.</p> 
<p>Give an adult a spelling test! How many of your words can they get correct?</p> 	<p>Sing your words.</p> 	<p>Say the word then jump for each letter, shouting them out as you jump.</p> 	<p>Make your spelling words using dough.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; color: red; text-align: center;"><b>the</b></p>
