PATHS & Health and Well-being

- In Mount Carmel, we encourage healthy eating and would appreciate your support and encouragement when providing snacks for break time and packed lunch.
- Children can bring a water bottle to school. The water bottle will be kept in the classroom. Water bottles should only contain water.
- We are a nut-free school and we ask you to be mindful of this and not include any food with nut traces.
- Pupils will continue with our whole school PATHS programme in P4. We will also continue with the 'Do Be Mindful' programme, promoting a range of mindful activities
- PE will take place on a Wednesday and Friday. Children should have PE kit and should be able to remove jewellery and earrings.

Spelling

- Spelling words issued weekly.
- A range of active spelling strategies used in class.
- Homework will include spelling tasks, please encourage your child to complete their spelling homework.







Reading

- Bug Club will be used as part of reading homework.
- We encourage you to read with your child.
- In class we will use a range of reading materials, including Bugclub.

Writing

- This term we will be focussing on descriptive writing.
- We will be using Descriptive Bubbles





Numeracy

This term we will be building on our sense of number, working with place value and a range of mathematical strategies.

The class will participate in a daily number talk to develop their mental maths strategies.

Children will have a maths task for homework.





Homework



Children will receive homework weekly.

Homework will be given out on a Monday and should be returned on a Friday.

Homework will consist of tasks such as spelling activity, a maths task and another activity.

Please support and encourage your child to complete homework tasks as these will help to consolidate their 'in school' learning.

As the year progresses, some tasks relating to the Sacraments will be given for homework.



Rainbow Reward

- •Rainbow reward takes place on a Friday afternoon. The children will be actively involved in choosing the activities they would like to do during rainbow reward.
- •Should a child have lost some of their Rainbow Reward Time, they will spend the time doing a reflection task.
- •We also promote positive behaviour through the "Star of the Week" certificates which are awarded weekly.
- •Children can also earn house points throughout the week, these can be awarded for a wide range of reasons.



Learning Journals is a very secure platform which enables us to share with you some of the highlights of your child's learning.

Parent/Carers will be able to access their child's profile from home online.


