National Youth Pilgrimage to Perth Saturday 20th September


Every year, young people - youth and young adults - from across Scotland gather on pilgrimage. This year, we're gathering in Perth where we'll travel around the city visiting a variety of different sites of religious significance, including: St John's Kirk, the North Inch, and St John's Catholic Church, where we will end the day with Mass.

Over the course of the afternoon, young people will have the opportunity to meet others from across Scotland as they learn about some history of the Church in Scotland.

All of the input delivered during the day is tailored to the specific age group - whether youth or young adults - and it's always a fantastic experience.

The day runs from 12 noon to 5 pm. From Galloway, we will be running a free coach, picking up in Dumfries at 8 am, and Kilmarnock at 9.50 am. We will return approximately 7.00 pm to Kilmarnock, and 9.05 pm to Dumfries.

There is no charge, but young people are asked to bring a packed lunch and a snack for the journey home. We are hoping to provide pizza in Kilmarnock for all of the young people before the coach continues to Dumfries.

Join us as we gather for a weekend retreat to get ready for Advent and Christmas. The retreat begins on Friday at 6.00 pm, and continues until Sunday at 4.00 pm.

Over the weekend, we'll have a range of different activities led by the Youth Office Team and the team at Gowanbank, including: tree climbing, archery tag, nightline, silent disco, escape room, fire pit and much more!

And in between all of the activities we'll have times of talks, prayer, Mass - as well as time to socialise and for the young people to get to know one and other better.

The weekend is open to all young people in **P7-S4** and costs £160. The cost includes:

- Shuttle bus service from St Joseph's Church, Kilmarnock or St Teresa's, Dumfries (if required).
