Pupils in Primary 1-5 can continue to access a free school lunch. <u>Please follow this link to lunch menus</u>. Please discuss lunch choices with children before they come to school so that lunches can be easily ordered in the morning.

We are a nut free school, please do not send your child with items to school which may contain nuts as we have a child with a severe nut allergy. As a Health Promoting School please continue to consider carefully the snacks that are being sent to school. Fruit, breakfast bars, vegetables or a small packet of crisps is acceptable. Please do not send large packs of crisps or large chocolate bars to school. Sweets should be an occasional treat, not a daily snack. Please continue to send water bottles to school, these should not contain juice or flavoured water.
