Ana took part in a weight lifting competition where she placed 1st.

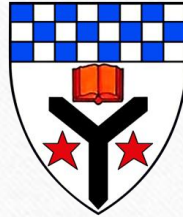

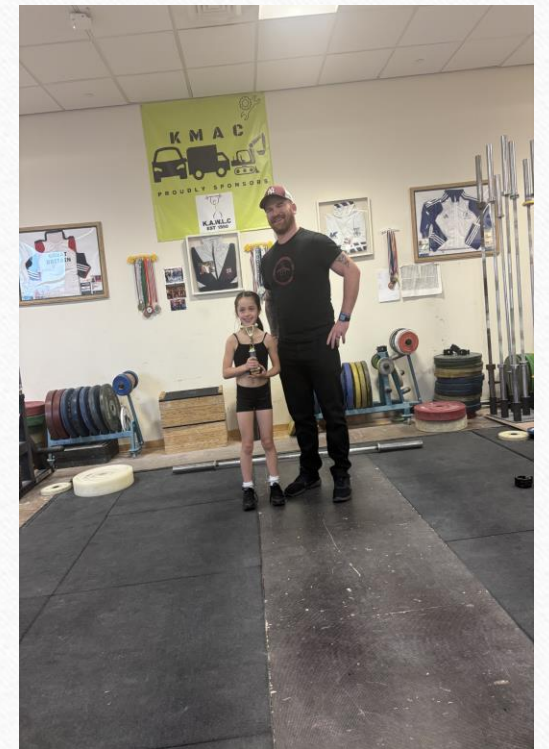

She's very proud of herself'

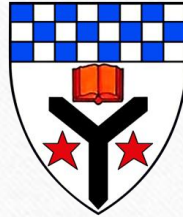
