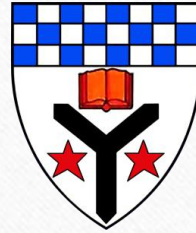

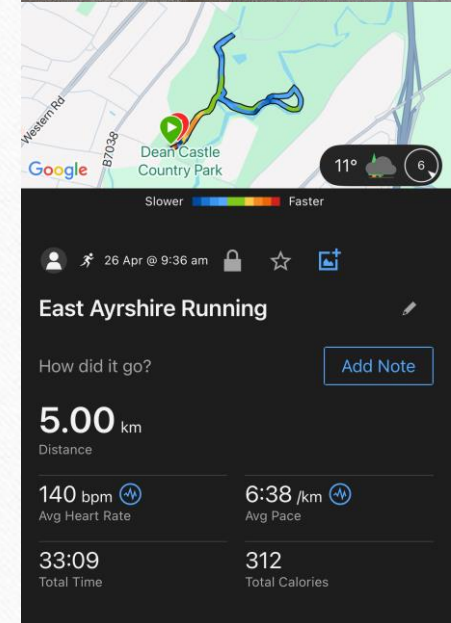


Robbie - P2

Well done everyone!

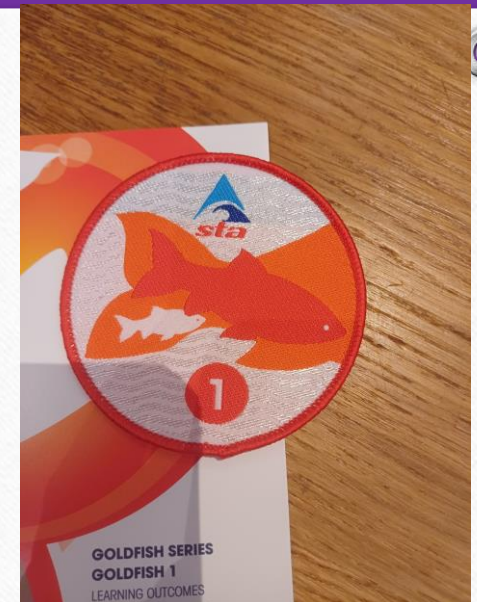


Zane - P3



Zane is doing really well at swimming. Just look at all his certificates!

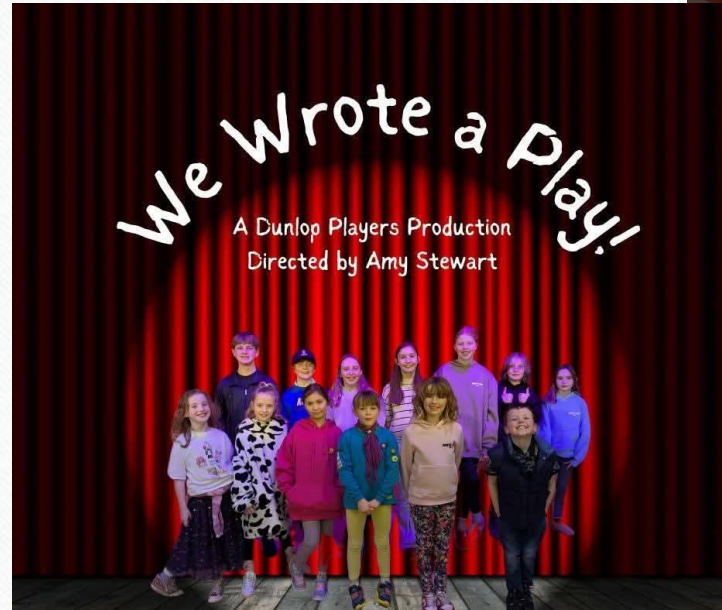

Liam - P3

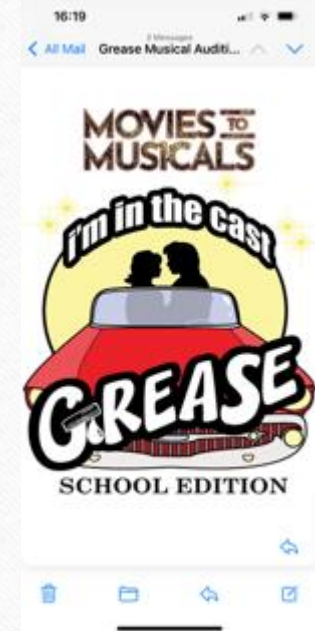
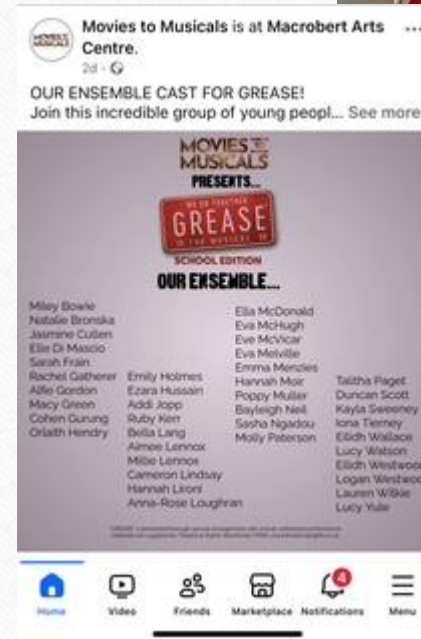

Ezara - P7

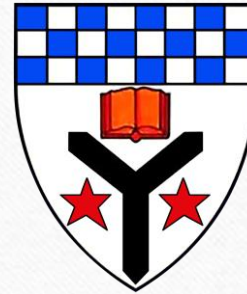
We are so proud of Ezara getting a place in the ensemble in the Grease show with Movies to Musicals

Oliver achieved his Swim Skills 1 certificate in May.

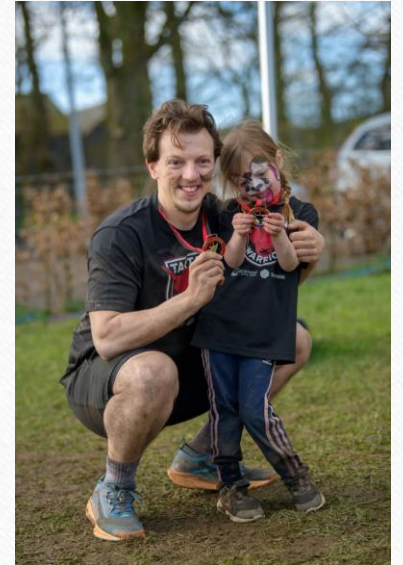
