Tae Kwon Do.

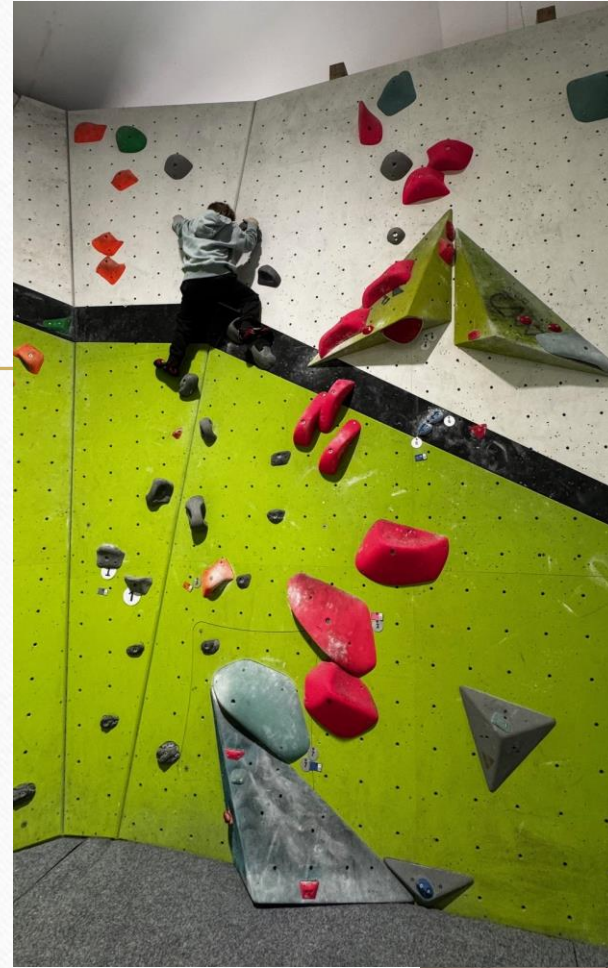

Niall – P1



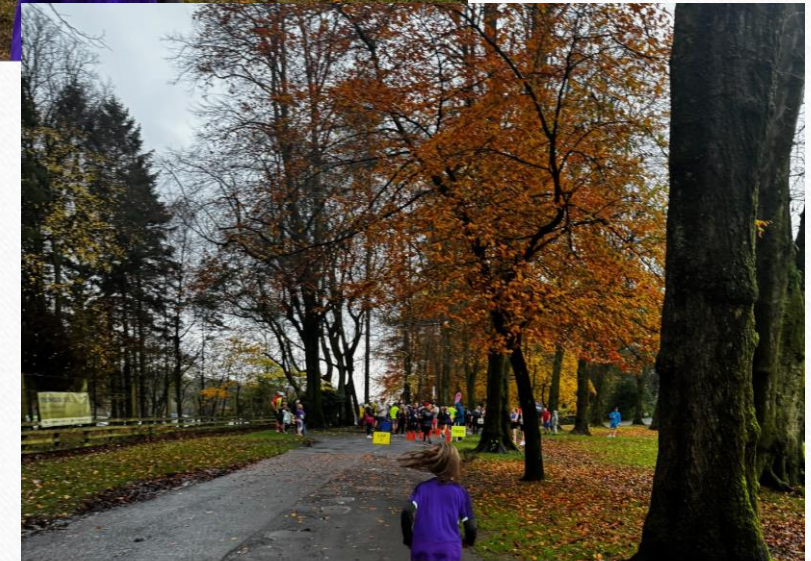
Niall has completed Grade 1 routes on the climbing wall at Above Adventure. He can also get to the top of the bouldering without a harness!

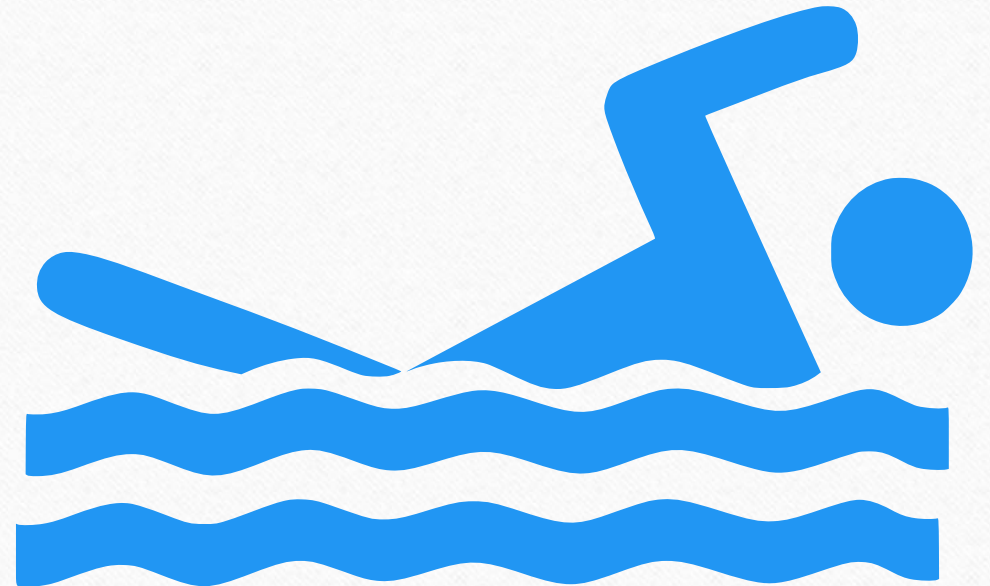
Antonio – P3
