Well done Georgia!




Ana - P4

Well done Ana!




Orran - P3




Orran passed the next level of his swimming lessons Goldfish 1 and will now move on to Goldfish 2.

During the recent very icy weather Riley insisted on helping to clear the ice for our neighbours, many of who are elderly.


Mum and Dad are so incredibly proud of what a caring, helpful and empathetic girl they have.



Well done Thomas!






Max - P5
