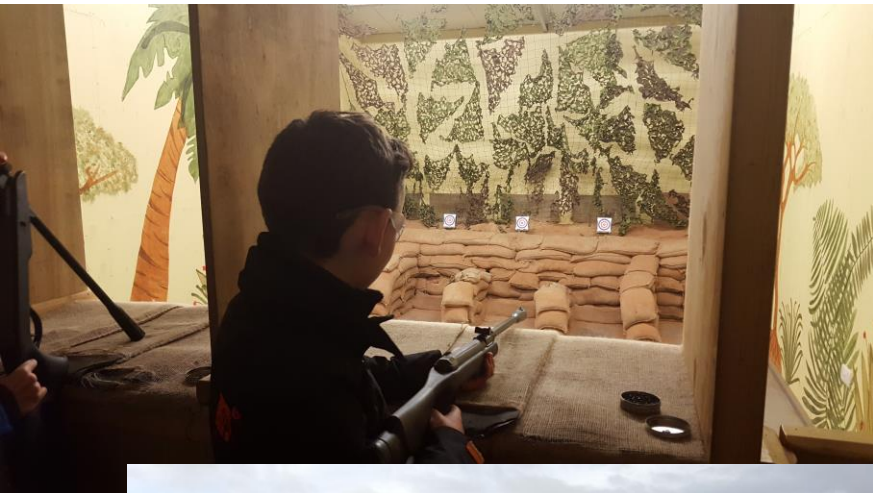

Timings/ Meals

- ▶ Bus leaves Stewarton Academy at 12.45pm. Arrival approx. 2.15pm on Monday 18th May
- ▶ Unpack, safety briefings, dinner + 2 activities
- ▶ 5 activities + meals on each full day.
- ▶ Breakfast, 2 activities, lunch + depart approx. 12.45pm Friday 23rd May
- ▶ Arrival at Stewarton Academy approx. 2.15pm

- ▶ Due to having to get the bus from Stewarton Academy, wheeled baggage is recommended!



Food

- ▶ All medical and dietary information we have on your child will be communicated to Lockerbie Manor. A form is currently live for the above.
- ▶ Dinner on the Monday evening will be our first meal and Lunch on Friday will be our last.
- ▶ Pupils can feel free to bring their own snacks for in between.
- ▶ There is a tuck-shop where pupils can buy additional snacks. We recommend a maximum of £10 for this, and it is entirely optional. This will also have to be cash. Change preferred!

Pods...

- ▶ Pods sleep 4 people and pupils will write down who they'd like to share with 2 weeks prior to the trip.
- ▶ Hair dryers/ Straighteners are permitted.
- ▶ A sleeping bag, pillow and pillow case will be required to be brought by every child.
- ▶ Pupils will also be required to bring towels.

Phones and devices...

- ▶ It is Lockerbie Manor's recommendation that phones and devices are not brought to the centre.
- ▶ There will be no access to wifi and 4G/5G is poor.
- ▶ There is also a lack of sockets for the purpose of charging.
- ▶ It is therefore our decision that phones/devices should NOT be brought on the trip.
- ▶ Children who need to contact home will be able to do this using staff devices.
