Well done Hollie!



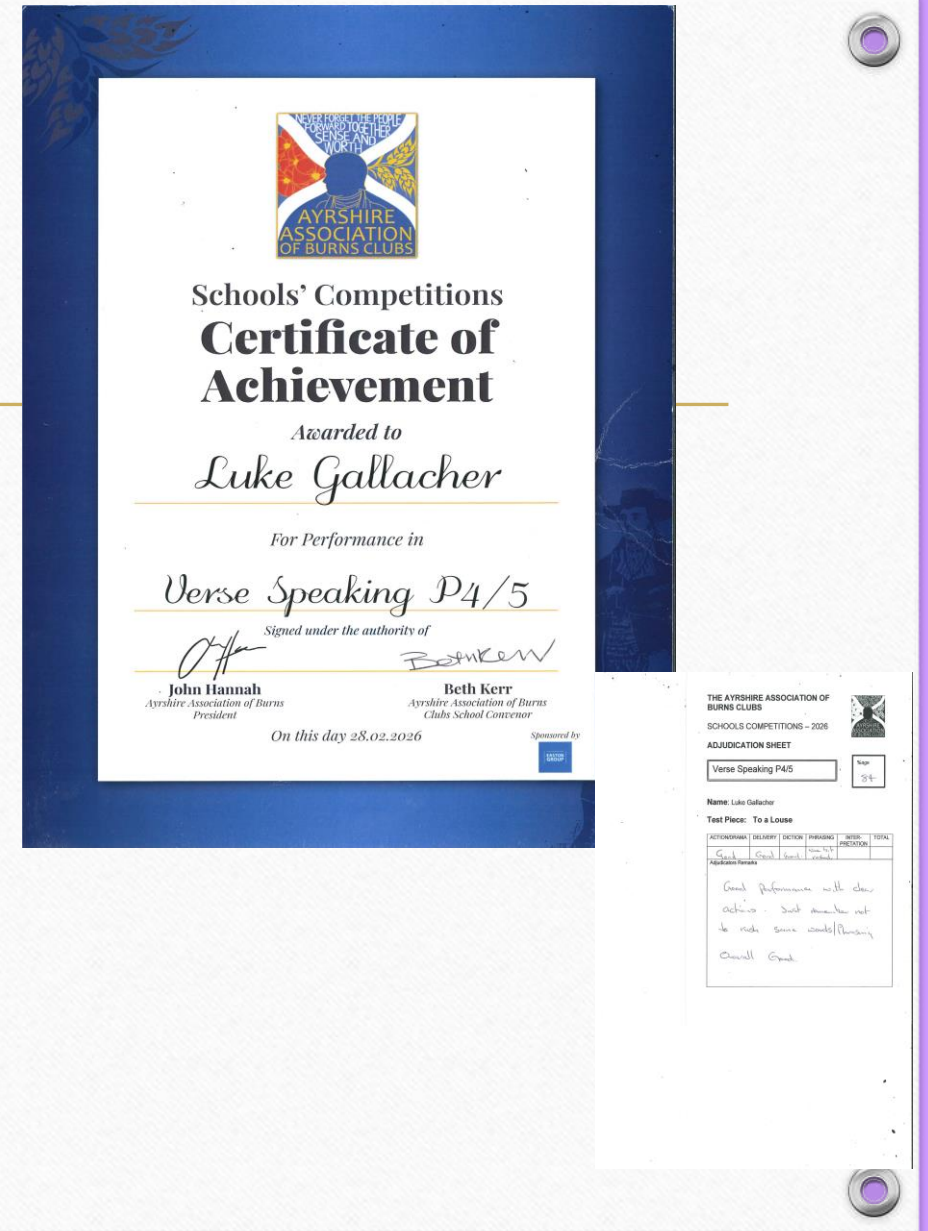
Luke P5

Well done Luke!



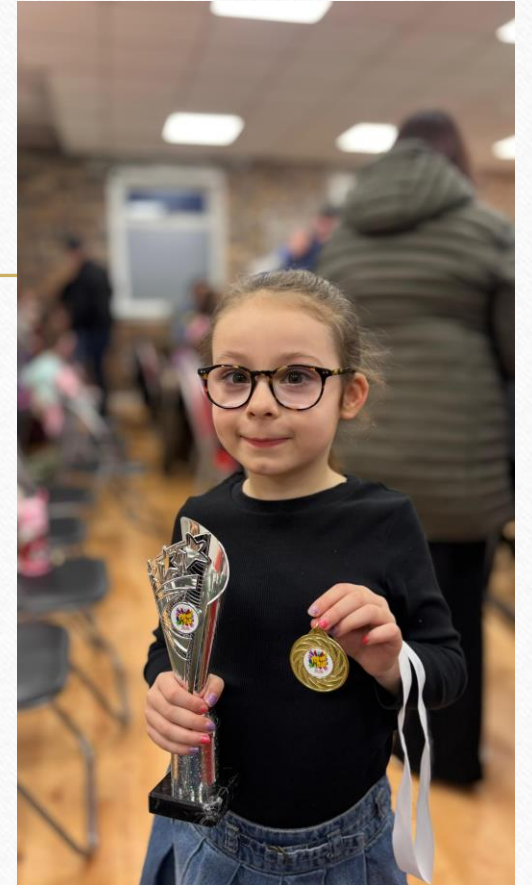
Harriet P2

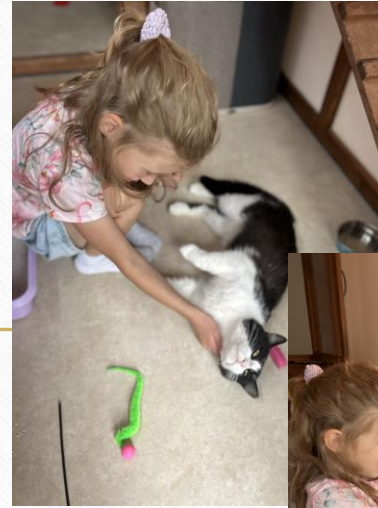


Ailsa P3
