Protection

Stay Shaded -

Shaded areas in our school are found near the walls, in the outdoor classroom, on the stage, the nursery walkway and under the big umbrellas

Cover up -

Wear hats that are wide brimmed. Try to cover your neck, ears and face.

If you are in a wheel chair and have shorts on cover your legs with a blanket.

Wear T-shirts and not vest tops with thin straps, so that your shoulders are covered.

Drinking -

Drink lots of water, especially if you are running around.

Bring in water bottles or plastic cups every day. These can be filled up in the school.

Sun Cream -

Put sun cream on when we are outside during playtime and learning. Put on our sun cream before we come to school. Parents should put sun cream on infants before they come to school.

We should bring a bottle of sun cream to school with us – our names should be clearly marked on the bottle. Teacher will give you a label if you need one.
