if any is needed.




My Daily Routine at School:

In the morning between 8:45 - 9:00 I can be dropped off by my parent/carer/adult at the school gate where an adult from the school will be there to welcome me.




I will hang my jacket on my peg in the corridor. My peg will have my name on it. (I will need my name on my clothes, so we don't get mixed up.)
