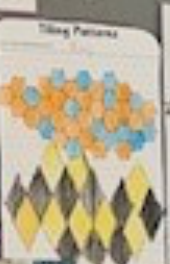

6. Write down what you think has happened (your conclusion).

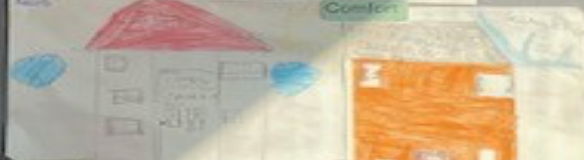
