PUNCTUALITY

School begins at 9am, it is the expectation that children arrive on time for school and remain until 3pm

Being late on occasion is understood, however pupils arriving late for class, even by just a few minutes can be disruptive to themselves and others and can lead to missed learning. The same is true when children leave early.

SHARED EXPECTATIONS



WE EXPECT CHILDREN TO BE PRESENT IN SCHOOL EACH DAY. IF FOR ANY REASON CHILDREN ARE ABSENT, PARENTS/CARERS MUST CONTACT THE OFFICE AND GIVE A REASON FOR THE ABSENCE.

POOR ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL HAS BEEN LINKED TO LOWER LEVELS OF ATTAINMENT; PEER RELATIONSHIPS; EMOTIONAL AND BEHAVIORAL DIFFICULTIES AND POORER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES LATER IN LIFE.
