

Make your own Tortoise



You will need:

- plastic tubs
- paint
- coloured paper
- glue
- glitter – optional

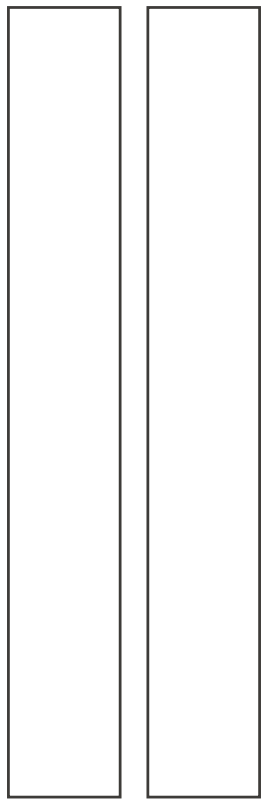
How to:

First paint and decorate your plastic tubs.

To make sparkly spots, add spots of glue using a paintbrush and sprinkle liberally with glitter, then blow the excess off. When using glitter it is a good idea to put a tray underneath your art or craft and it will help to contain the mess, or else use it outside.

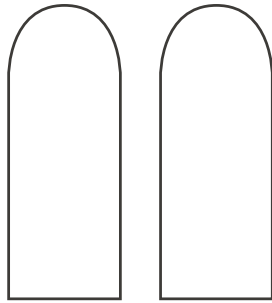
Once the glue has dried, paint over the top of the glitter with DIY mod podge (a mix of 50% pva glue and 50% water) to stop the flecks from going everywhere after you make the craft.

Use the Tortoise template for the body parts and attach these with glue.

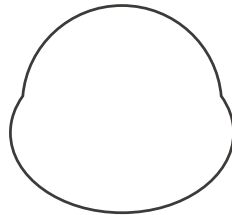
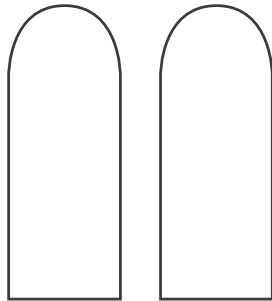


Neck

Legs

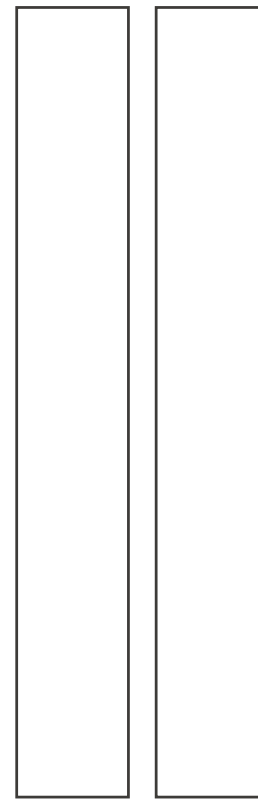


Head

draw your own face

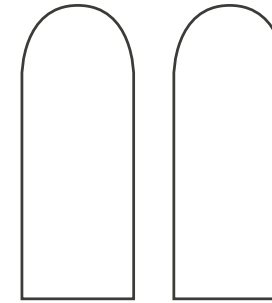


Tail

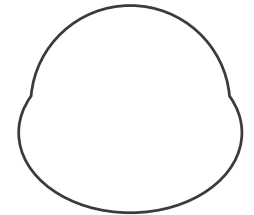
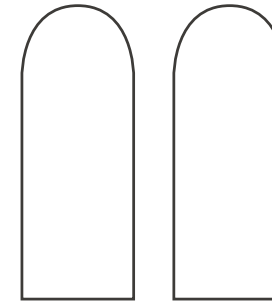


Neck

Fold these two pieces into a paper spring

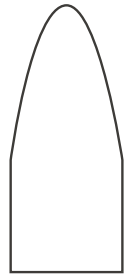


Legs
