 <p>Measurement Is it longer or shorter?</p> <p>Use a pencil to look round your house for something longer or shorter. Find 10 things longer and 10 things shorter. What was the longest thing you found and which was the shortest? How many pencil lengths was the longest thing you found?</p> <p>Ask everyone in your household to stand in a line. Can you organise them from tallest to shortest? Who is the tallest and who is the shortest?</p> <p>Using cubes or blocks (lego or building blocks) can you first estimate (guess) how many cubes the following objects are. 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Common words

Can you please help your child learn to **recognise** these words by writing them (bubble writing, colourful writing, squiggly writing, fancy writing) or with materials outside. Drawing a line around each word and looking at the shape of the word. Talking about tall and small letters. You can use your magnetic letters to say, make, read and write these words.

Writing

Talk about what you are going to write first and maybe draw a picture before you start to write. Remember each sentence has to have a capital letter, full stop and finger space. I would like to see you on one occasion link 2 sentences together using the word **and** or **because**. Remember to include the prompts we have been talking about in school:

When?

Who?

What?

Where?

How did I feel.?

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Sounds

Say, make, break, blend, read and write using words from the list. Your child will be able to tell you what to do! Don't show your child the word, just say it to them. Use the magnetic board.
