

When you are on this screen you need to add all the words you want in your finished piece. Do this by typing your word where it says 'type in new word' then push return to add a new word. You can add as many as you like.

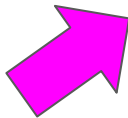



# Step 5: Change colour and size

Next to each of your words is the size and colour columns. They are set at default but you can change these by clicking on them and selecting a colour you like. In your finished work words will show in your chosen colour.

Size is a number between 1-10 with 10 being the biggest. Just type a number to change sizes.


