

## Remote Learning at Patna Primary School & SLC

- Primary 3-7 will use GLOW Teams (EAC Guidance does not allow schools to use GLOW with pupils in P1 & P2). Class teachers will use advanced features in Teams to interact with and motivate pupils. The majority of pupils should know how to access Teams. If you are having trouble please let us know. If your child has not logged on after a few days we will give you a call to offer support. We understand it can be frustrating to set up initially.
