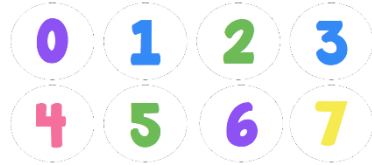

Watch a film, then talk with your family about the strengths you spotted in the various characters in the film. Give examples of how they used those strengths.



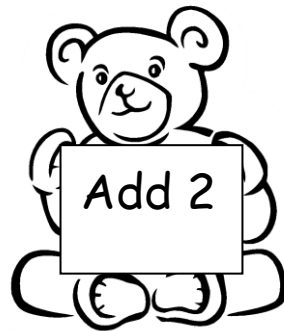
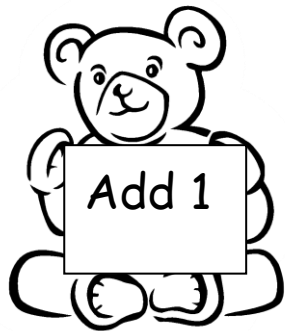
Get Active!
