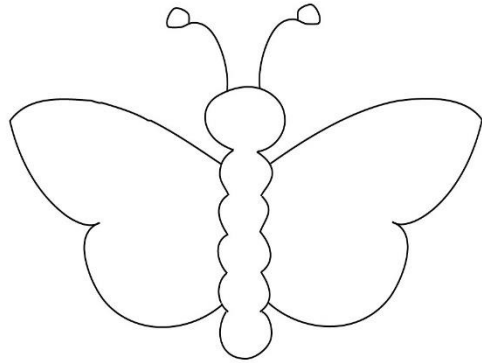


1. How many ways can you make 10? Put dots different ways on the butterfly's wings.

<p><u>Make a rhyme</u></p> <p>Can you match the pairs that rhyme?</p> <p>Cat run boat bed mop</p> <p>Sun hat hop sled</p> <p>Once you've made the matches can you think of a silly sentence that has all the rhyming words in it?</p>	<p><u>Sound Detectives:</u></p> <p>How many c, k and ck words can you think of?</p> <p>Can you spot any 'c', 'k' or 'ck' objects in your house?</p> 	<p><u>Spelling Words</u></p> <p>Can your grownup or sibling give you a spelling test on last week's words? Sound them out or jump and clap for each letter!</p> <p><u>P1 words</u> - be, but, you</p> <p><u>P2 words</u> - one, first, little</p>
<p><u>Sound Sorter</u></p> <p>Get a selection of objects and ask your child to sort them into two groups - those that contain a c, k or ck sound and those that do not.</p>	<p><u>Your choice!</u></p> <p>Pick a story to read together, any time you read a word that has a c, k or ck sound in it:</p> <p>Point to it! Trace it in the air! Say it!</p>	<p><u>Make the posties route</u></p> <p>Build the route that the Jolly Postman takes through the snow delivering all the letters, using construction blocks.</p> <p>What does he see on the way? Who is lurking behind the trees?</p>
<p><u>The Jolly Christmas Postman</u></p> <p>Reread the story with your grownup, talk about what bits you liked and what bits you disliked.</p> <p>What was your favourite stop on the posties route?</p> <p>Try and act out the story using any props or costumes you have at home. Or make paper puppets! Have fun, try silly voices!</p>	<p><u>Jolly Phonics - Favourite sound</u></p> <p>Here is the link to the Jolly Phonics song, can you sing it with your grownups! Don't forget all of the actions too!</p> <p>A-a-ants on my arm...</p> <p>https://youtu.be/2Xy2e78qxNg</p> <p>Pick your favourite sound from the song and draw a poster all about that sound, include pictures of words or names that have that sound.</p>	<p><u>Memory Game</u></p> <p>Pack a few items in a basket or tub, things that Red Riding Hood might take with her to grandma's house, such as an apple, a book, a pencil, a phone. Show your child the items and ask them to remember them all, then cover the items with a cloth. How many can they remember? For more challenge add more items! Or take one away, can your child work out which is gone... perhaps the Big Bad Wolf took it!</p>
