Look up their meaning in a dictionary. You can use:

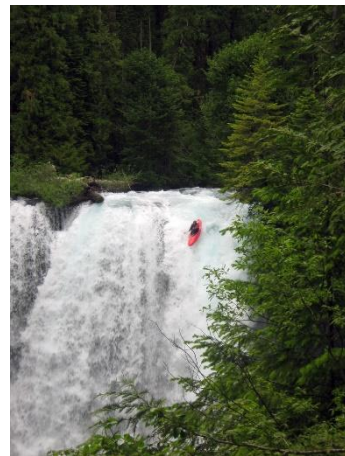
