What are we learning this term?

Term 2 2021/22

We have had a very busy first term. The children really enjoyed completing their snapshot jotters to bring home to you to share their learning and we hope you enjoyed the brief insight into their learning. Please do not hesitate to contact me via the school office if you have any queries. We will be using our class blog to let you know what we have been doing in the classroom. We are busy now working on our Nativity performance, which everyone is excited about.

Language & Literacy

P1 continue to learn new letter sounds, recognise and hear sounds within words. We are continuing with developing correct letter formation. They are starting to blend sounds together to read words independently.

P2 continue to develop phonics knowledge through the Active Literacy programme and develop their reading skills and strategies to decode unfamiliar words. In writing we continue to develop independent sentence writing, focusing on using capital letters and full stops correctly, letter formation.

P1/2 will explore a variety of reading and writing skills using the text 'Harris the Hero'. We are exploring reading skills using the 'Find it' strategy to find information in the text to show our understanding.



Numeracy & Mathematics

P1 will be reading, writing, matching and ordering, numbers to 30, and learning the number words. They are exploring symmetry and creating and completing symmetrical pictures.

P2 - Continuing to develop numbers to 100, through ordering, finding the missing number and counting forwards and backwards in 1's, 2's, & 10's and will explore place value.

We are exploring finding line symmetry in shapes and objects and patterns.

P1/2 are exploring information handling, to gather, display and interpret information. (pictograms and bar charts)



Health & Wellbeing

In PE, we are developing our ball handling skills, throwing, catching and bouncing skills through a variety of games.



In HWB the pupils will explore the importance of safety using the internet. We will also be investigating the importance of foods to keep us healthy and where our foods come from. We will be learning about safe and unsafe substances and how to stay safe around these.



Contexts for Learning - Percy the Park Keeper

This term, pupils will explore features of parks in their local environment. Pupils will develop simple mapping skills and work in groups to design and create their own park. Pupils will also develop their knowledge of the importance of looking after our environment. They will explore how the weather can affect everyday life e.g clothing and activities and link seasons and types of weather and use simple weather symbols to describe types of weather.
