Symmetry and Patterns Look for patterns and symmetry in your outdoor environment. Draw or photograph what you find.	Fractions Create a fraction wall by breaking sticks into halves and quarters. Door Numbers Look around at the door numbers in your local area. Add the numbers on the door together, e.g. number 87 - $8+7=15$ or see if you can double or halve them.
