Language & Literacy

In term 4 pupils will complete the remaining active spelling phonemes and will continue to develop their grammar knowledge of parenthesis, apostrophes and proofreading.

In reading we have started our final novel study of the year, 'Holes'. This is a hugely enjoyable text for pupils and they will further develop their active reading skills through this study. We will also study a poem with a view to writing a critical essay on this in preparation for learning in S1.

Pupils will be encouraged to continue personal reading at home either on BugClub or with a text of their choice.

Numeracy & Mathematics

In numeracy pupils will continue their Number Talks learning to encourage



mental agility and problem solving skills. They are currently working on measure, looking at perimeter, area and volume. With Miss Corrigan they have been exploring co-ordinates and grid references by creating their own battleships game!

Later in the term they will learn about angles and time before we revise our P7 learning before the summer break.

Pupils should engage with Sumdog at home which is being set as part of homework.

Health & Wellbeing

P.E. – We are currently working on fitness and fielding games in P.E. Pupils have enjoyed their recent athletics lessons where they sent away scores to be entered in to the sports hall athletics heats. We hope to complete some work on tennis too.



Health & Wellbeing – In health we are learning about parenting. This short unit of study will involve learning what babies and toddlers need, how to take care of them and the role of a parent.

There will also be many opportunities to learn about planning for choices and change through the transition programme where pupils will be able to explore their emotions.

Wider Curriculum

This term the class are busy preparing for their leavers assembly! They are learning lines, creating props and revising song lyrics to put on a great performance to mark the end of their seven years at KPS.
