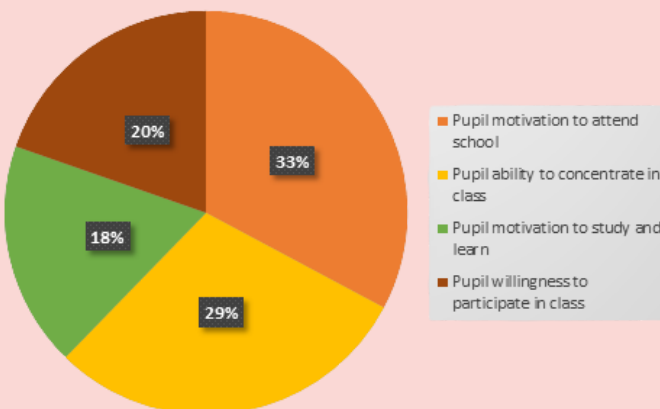

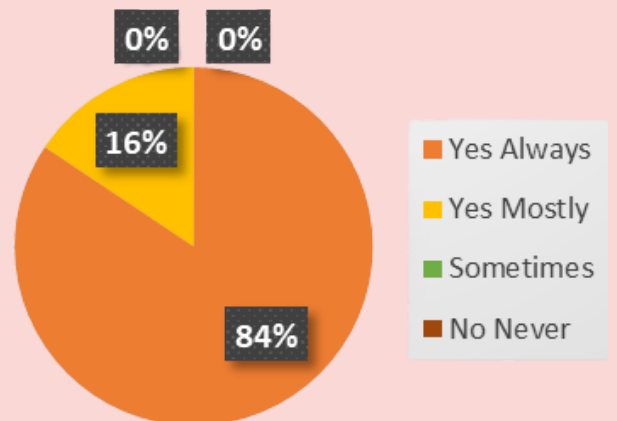
Were Young People Seen Quickly by the School Counselling Service?

"Pupils have told me they have really benefitted from speaking with the counsellor and seem far more settled in school."

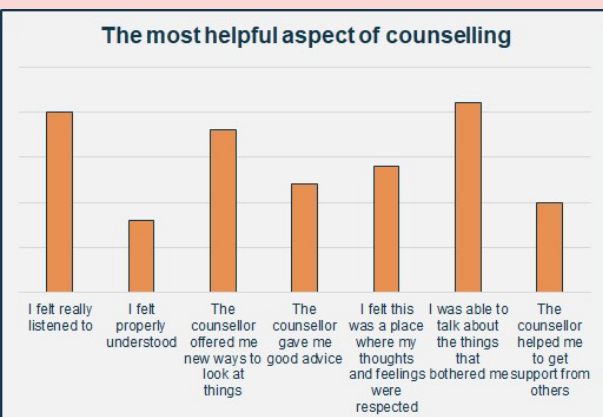

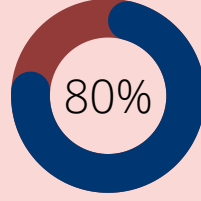
