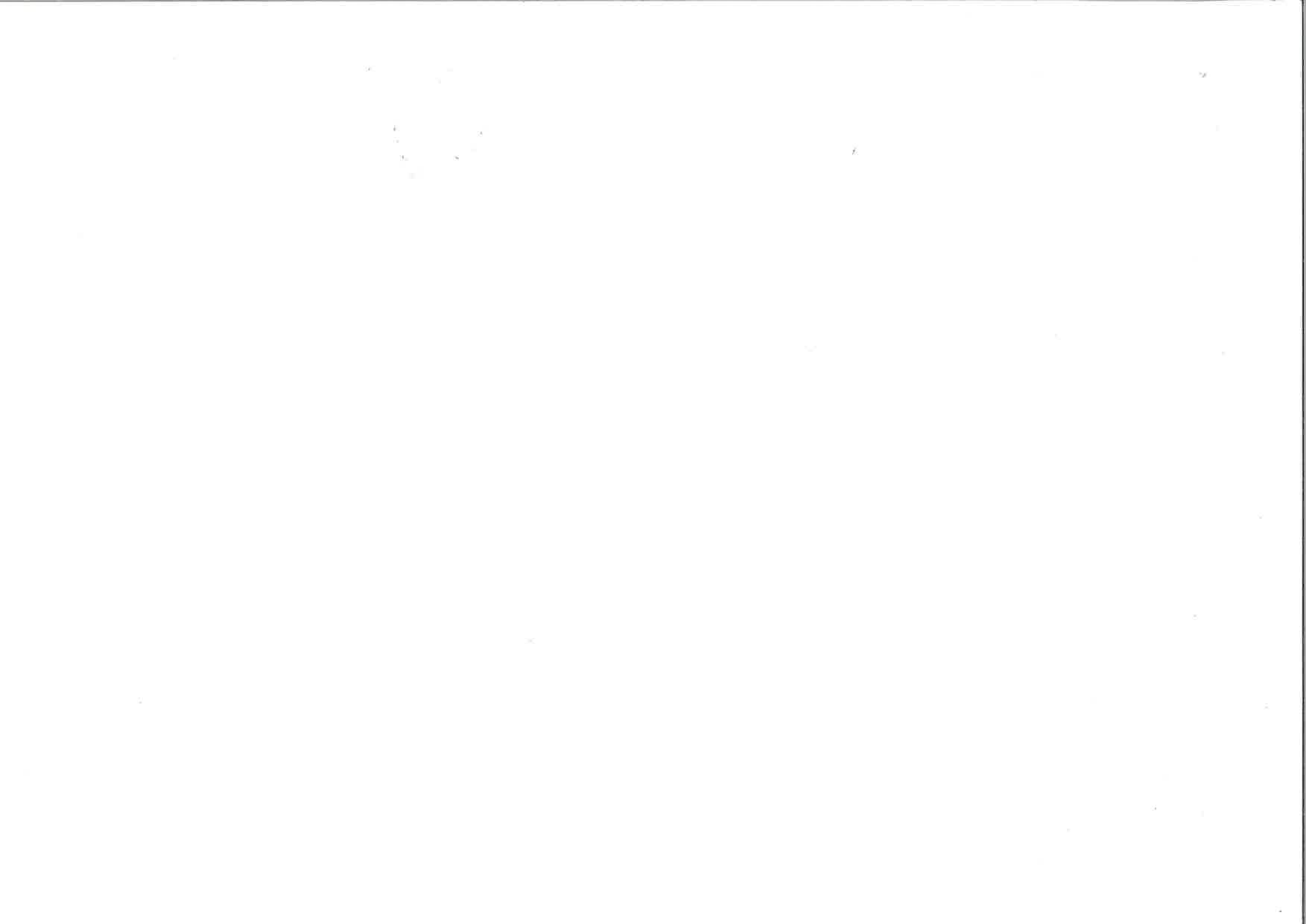
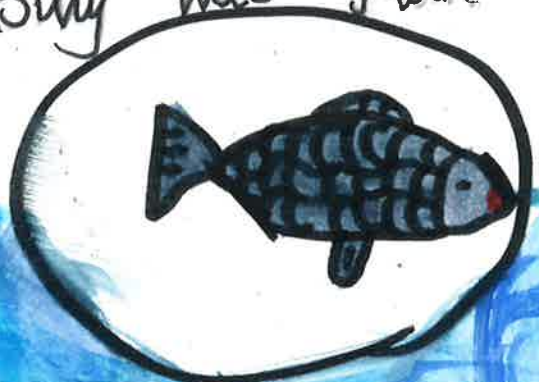

Wance he wis at the edge, he phoned the police oan the telephonic line.



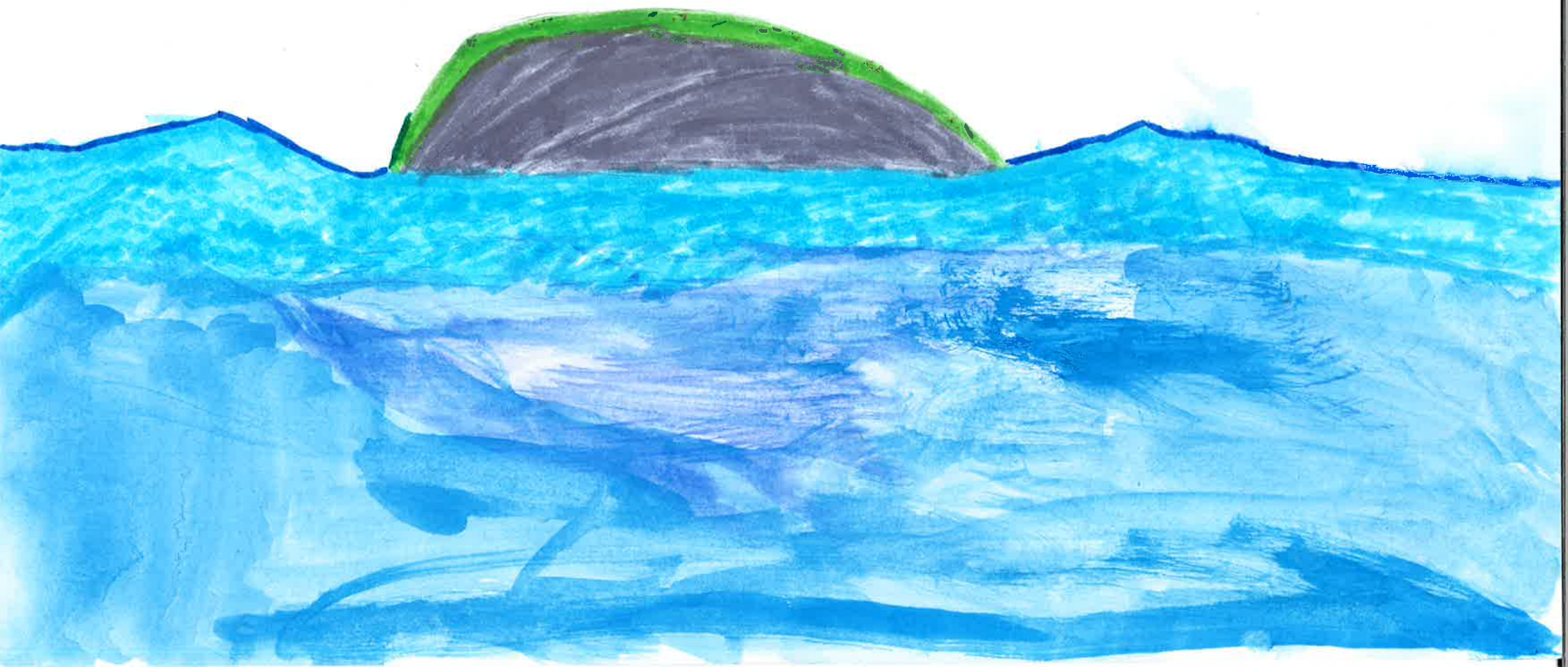

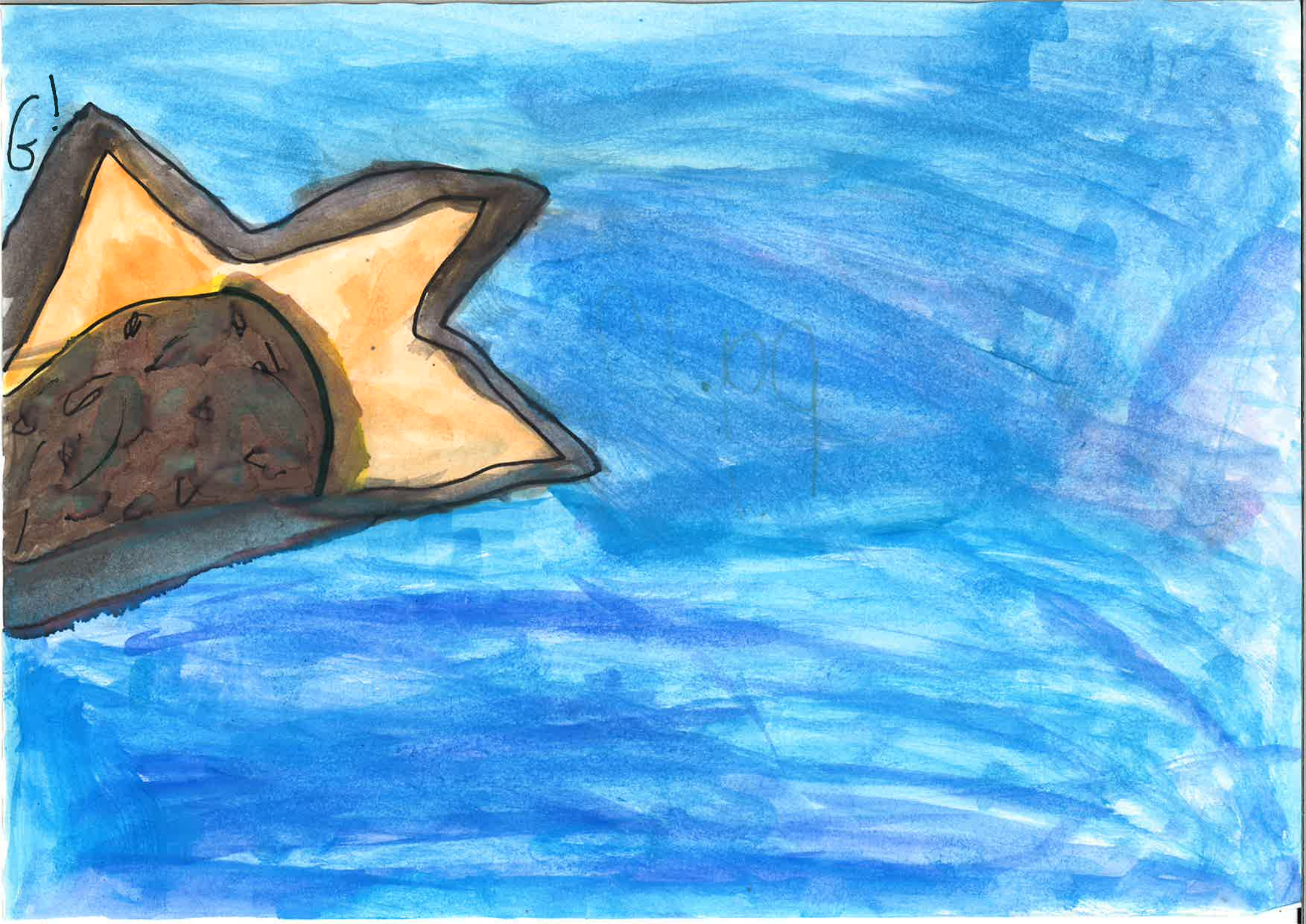


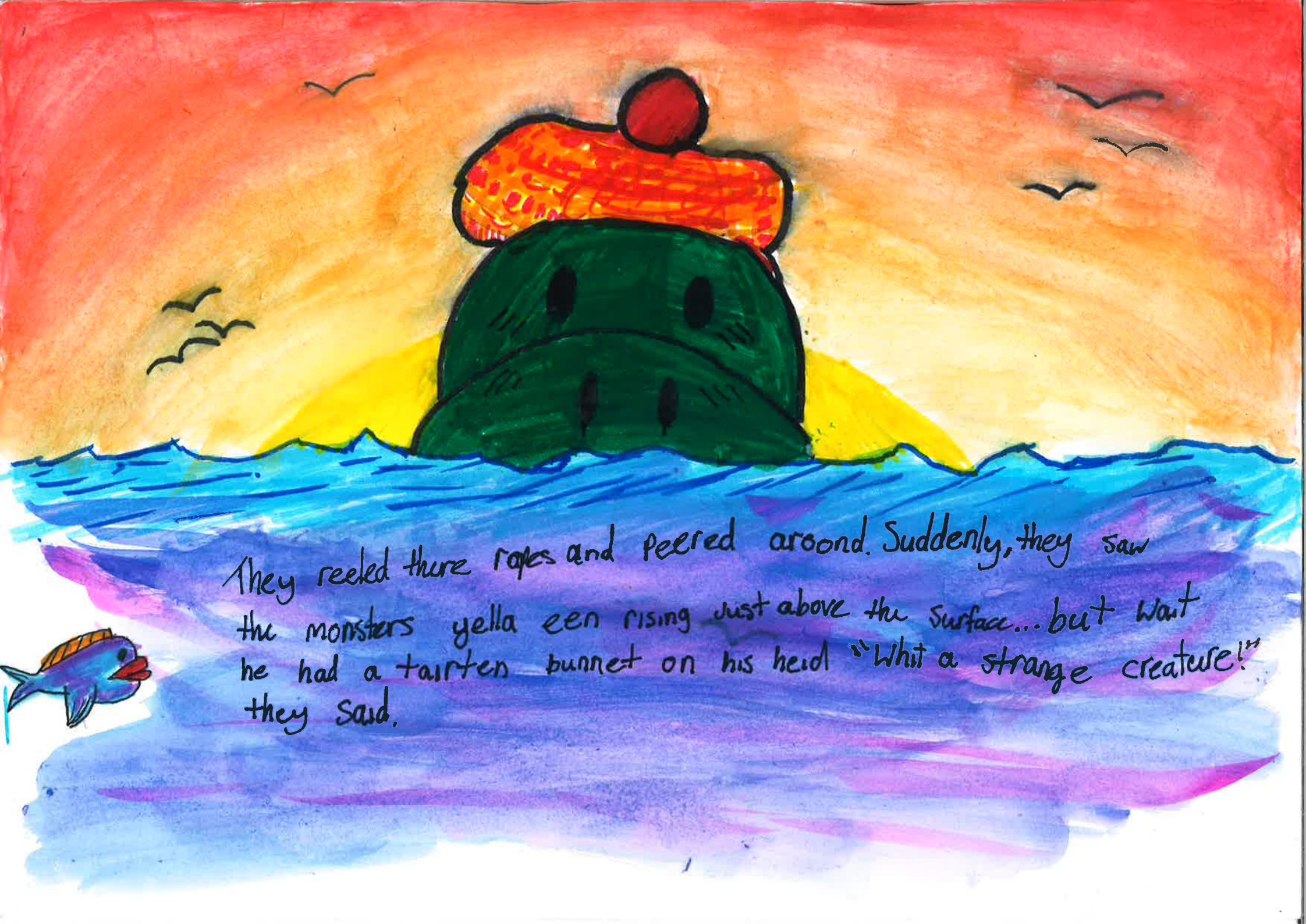


SPLASH!
