
Mrs Abercrombie

Water play activities help to develop and strengthen children's gross and fine motor skills. Children enhance their gross motor skills, coordination and physical fitness through lifting, pouring, carrying, running and splashing, while actions such as squeezing help to develop the small muscles in a child's hands. This can be achieved with a basin and empty tubs, getting them to 'wash' the dishes or playing in the bath.
