

Common Words Menu



Here is a list of activities to complete for our common word homework in Primary 1. You will be given a list of **3 common words** every week. Please use these words to complete one of the following activities each week.

Make sure you try a different activity each week.

In addition to the activity you choose, **you must also always complete activity 1** (look, say, cover, write, check) every week. This will give you plenty of practice when learning your new words.

1. LSCWC – Look at the word, say it, cover it, write it down and check to see if you have written your word correctly.

2. Pyramid Writing
Form a pyramid for each of your words.
For example:
w
we
wen
went

3. Pasta words
Use dry pasta to make your words. You can glue them onto paper or simply take a picture and post it on the school app.

4. Upper/lower case
Write your words using upper case and lower case letters.

wEnT

5. Newspaper words
Find your words in an old newspapers or magazines, cut them out and stick them in your jotter.

6. Messy words
Spray a small amount of shaving foam or whipped cream onto a plate and spread it out. Write your spelling words in the foam. Make sure you clean up afterwards!

It would be helpful if an adult at home could sign and date the activity completed, as some activities do not require evidence in your jotter.
