# Literacy

## Phonics and Spelling

We will be using the Active Literacy programme for phonics and spelling. Primary 1 will begin to focus on joined phonemes and common spelling words, with revision of all initial sounds and Primary 2/3 will continue with joined phonemes and common words. We will be using the say, make/break, blend, read, write strategy to help us decode and encode and will continue to word build using our single and joined phonemes.

## Reading

We will be focusing on a few small book studies this term which will allow us to explore some different comprehension strategies such as 'Find it, Prove it, Talk about it'. We will be looking at 'The Rainbow Fish' and 'Zog' as our focus stories. We will also be making links to reading through our 'Space' topic. There will be focus on exploring different types of texts such as Fiction and Non-fiction.

## **Writing**

This term we will be focusing on using VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation) within our writing. **Primary 1** will begin to explore sequencing events within a story where **Primary 2/3** will be looking to create their own stories with beginning, middle and end. We will be linking our writing to both book studies - writing about characters and the setting. We will begin to look at the concept of 'making notes' for a specific purpose.

#### Numeracy

This term, we will extend our knowledge and skills across a wide range of numeracy concepts. Primary 1 will focus on exploring numbers to 20 and number bonds, addition and subtraction, patterns, 2d and 3d shape, fractions, money and data handling. Primary 2/3 will focus on addition and subtraction, multiplication, fractions, money, patterns and data handling.



# NUMBER TALKS

#### Number Talks

We will continue to work on our 'Number Talks' programme. Number Talks enhances mental agility and we will be focussing specifically on number bonds. Children are encouraged to articulate their thinking, explaining why they have chosen a particular strategy.
