Article 28- You have the right to an education.

Article 17- You have the right to collect information from the media.

Article 12- You have the right to your opinion.

When giving our opinion either verbally or online we will respect the opinions of others.

Teachers will ask pupils for feedback and value their thoughts and opinions.

Article 3- All adults will do what is best for you.

We will inform an adult if anything we see online makes us feel unsafe, unsure or uncomfortable.

Teachers will ensure that we are aware of how to stay safe online and will take appropriate action if our online safety is compromised.

Article 42- You have a right to learn about your rights.
