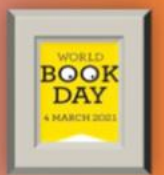


# Sorn Primary School

In addition to this, classes will have more sessions planned around reading throughout the week.

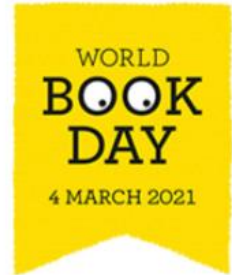
We hope you'll join us to make this day special as we continue to encourage a love of books and reading.

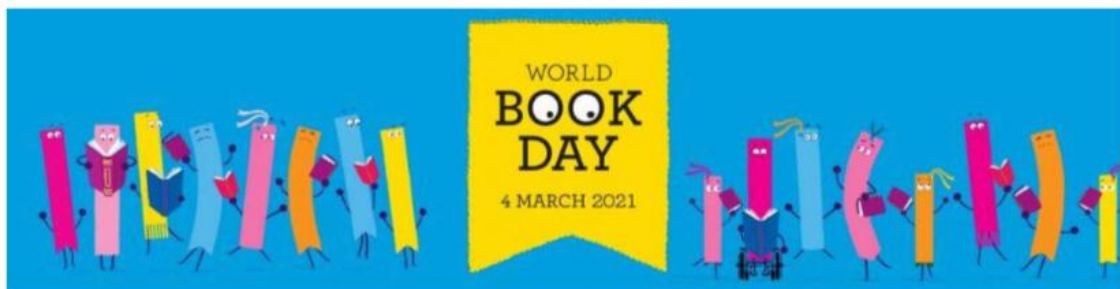

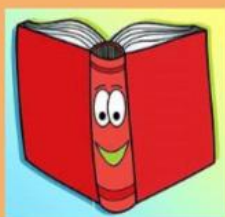
## Book Trail

8. Who was our mystery guest for Book Trail 8 – who was the author of his favourite book?

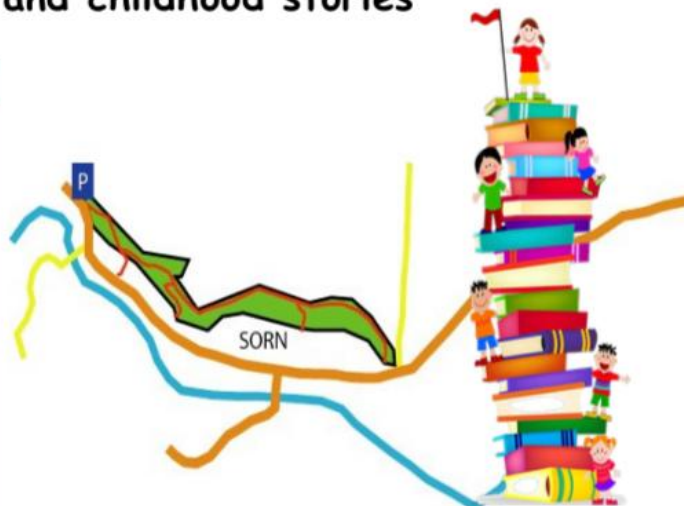
