4. Strategic Matters

Course Information Guidance

In advance of options exercises, and in an attempt to provide clearer transparency, each PT has been working with staff to develop N5 and Higher course guides for every subject in the school. A sample has been issued to you. These guides will be posted online and included in any options information shared with parents/carers.

Launch of Childcare with Outdoor Learning

In partnership with the Prince's Trust and Ayrshire College, we have launched our Childcare with Outdoor Learning course. We have converted one of the unused Drama areas into a mini nursery, and those completing the course have spent time setting the area up in advance of working with nursery pupils from St. Andrew's nursery.

This course offers a pathway to a college course in S4.

Launch of Parental Engagement Sessions

Our Home Link Workers, along with Mr Boyle and several teaching staff have now started a twelve session weekly programme for parents/carers of targeted young people. Reasons for attending are vary, but the focus is on how we can support one another to secure meaningful engagement from young people. At some sessions, young people and parents/carers work apart, while at others they work together. Topics covered include:

- Dealing with Teenage Behaviour
- Restorative Approaches
- Social Media
- Peer Group Issues

We will seek feedback from this project with a view to widening/extending.

Launch of Code of Conduct

As per last week's letter to all parents/carers, we will launch our code of conduct this week. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, with a review scheduled as part of our vision, values and aims consultation later in the session.

Curriculum Consultation

A consultation event will be held on Thursday 6th December at 7pm. We believe a review of our S3 structure is necessary for the following reasons:

- Currently unable to fulfil a young person's entitlement to learn in each curricular area
- Difficulty in ensuring appropriate pathways from some S3 columns to S4
- Lack of provision in relation to Drama, Computing, Business and Administration
- Some unusually high allocations to English, Maths and Modern Languages when viewed against local and national patterns

Further detail will be shared on the evening, with response gathered and analysed prior to the options process. Responses will be shared with the Parent Council and then the wider Parent Forum prior to any decisions being taken.

ToK Research

The second of four surveys is now live and the link will be tweeted and emailed to parents/carers this week. You can still participate in the survey if you missed the first round. Initial data gathered via ToK following the first survey arrived last week, and will be analysed in due course. Patterns over the four surveys will assist us as we target the promotion of positive mental wellbeing.
