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IMPORTANT ASSESSMENT DIET INFORMATION

All assessments will take place in the **Games Hall** with the exception of the following;

Modern Languages listening assessments (ML Dept.)

Music and Music Technology assessments (Music dept.)

Candidates entitled to alternative assessment arrangements i.e. use of ICT or extra time will have alternative accommodation. These candidates should ensure they know their individual arrangements in advance of each assessment.

Candidates must follow all health & safety regulations in assessment locations such as sitting in allocated seats and zones, sanitising hands and entering and leaving assessment locations as instructed.

Candidates should arrive at least ten minutes before the assessment to ensure they know their seat number and the assessment can begin promptly.

Candidates are responsible for bringing all necessary equipment such as pens, pencils and calculators. Paper will be provided.

Full school uniform must be worn to all assessments and in school during the assessment diet.

Assessment papers must be placed in the drop box before leaving the assessment location.

School transport and catering arrangements will continue as normal during the assessment block.

If a candidate is unable to attend a scheduled assessment due to illness, parents/ carers should contact the school office on 01563 526144 as early as possible and leave a message stating the pupil name, year group, scheduled exam and reason for absence.

There is no official Study Leave during the May assessment period. We recommend that pupils attend timetabled classes when not in an exam. Teachers will be available as normal throughout the exam diet.

From Monday 24th May 2021 pupils should return to normal classes.

Evidence gathering for National Qualifications for 2021 will continue until early June and therefore all young people should ensure they attend to ensure they participate in all assessment tasks for their chosen courses.
