SQA Exams

Hillhouse were the winner of our Annual Youth Philanthropy Initiative. The winning pupils presented on behalf of Hillhouse to our panel of judges and were assessed against various criteria, ranging from presentation to knowledge of the charity in question. The team representing Hillhouse were victorious and YPI funding will be released to the local charity in the coming weeks.

Work Experience

Accounting for feedback received following the last Parent Council meeting, further clarity is provided in terms of Work Experience.

Our anticipated S6 roll for session 23/24 is currently seventy-two and is projected to settle at around sixty-eight. We have an agreement with East Ayrshire's Council of Voluntary Organisations to pilot a work experience programme in June of this year with full rollout from September. All S6 pupils will be offered a

CVO work experience placement that will run for several weeks. Placements will align with free/study periods as much as possible.

- All pupils guaranteed placement
- Majority extend into several weeks unlike previous model
- CVO will allocate against intended career path/industry
- Pupils can still 'self-find' or access other work experience placements via the Chamber of Commerce
 - o We cannot guarantee ongoing placement if this is the case
 - o Relevant paperwork need be submitted
- S5 who are known to be leaving e.g. Christmas Leavers will also be given the opportunity to participate
- We continue to advise that for some careers (Medicine, Dentistry, Law etc.) pupils either aim to source work experience outwith school or attempt to secure part time work where possible

All CVO placements had to be risk assessed and logged with the chamber prior to launch, hence the delay this session.
