1. General Update



Non-Statutory Subsidised Transport

East Ayrshire Council Cabinet has announced their decision to end non-statutory subsidised transport from June 2025. This means that any pupil using the school bus when residing within the three mile statutory limit will no longer have access to subsidised services, and must use alternative transport to get to school.

One point of clarity will be queried in terms of incidental pick up, for example, when a bus from Mauchline/Auchinleck/Cumnock passes through Hurlford, some pupils in Hurlford and surrounding areas do qualify for access to the bus and others do not. Where seating capacity allows, we will determine with transport their intention or otherwise to continue to allow pupils to use services within Hurlford if just outside the area of limit.

Attainment
