

English

Teachers will be uploading work onto Teams for pupils over Easter. Work will help them study for RUAE, Scottish Set Text and Critical Essay. There will also be materials on Teams from previous weeks which pupils can go back to for consolidation.

The SQA can be accessed for past papers and BBC Bitesize is excellent for accessing revision on the texts being used. Homework booklets have been issued previously which pupils should use to practice from.

There is a real need to revise key quotations from the Scottish Set Text and from the literature text. Teachers will have advised pupils what these are through learning and teaching. Pupils can create revision walls or mind maps to help remember these quotations for use in assessments. Pupils should go back to the critical essays they have had returned and improve them using the feedback from their teacher. It is also strongly advised that pupils try writing to time at home as part of their study.

It is also important that any pupils who have yet to submit their folio piece to their teacher be done as a matter of urgency. This is compulsory and, without it, they cannot be entered for the English qualification.

Biology

N5 pupils also have a scientific literacy booklet as these are now a standard part of the N5 paper. All of the booklets outlined are also available on the Teams pages for pupils to access along with the PowerPoints for the final unit of work that we have been working on since January. All assignments on Teams pages can still be accessed and completed if pupils have not already done so and we recommend using the BBC Bitesize website as another revision tool. Physics

There are a number of steps pupils can take to improve their grade in Physics.

Pupils who did not engage with online learning have been given chunked, structured and targeted work to help 'catch up' with submission dates for each section. It is important for all pupils to ensure this work is completed to ensure full coverage of the course content required for future assessments.
