1. Meeting started off with discussions over Halloween disco. Everything went well except issues with children and throwing water everywhere .
2. Treasurer Report – last balance £3501, income since £1270, stalls etc £105, outgoings £1804
3. Discussion over Christmas fair. Tables allocated for kip migration and Whatriggs primary classes. Looking for donations for raffle. Alison has emailed about janitor for the day.
4. Grahams input – introduction about his role within Vibrant Communities. Points covered including mental health and wellbeing, community action plans; services available and sessions at the well for parents (agreed to give a table for community action plan to aid in results) and community grants (reduction to £500)
