



Logo Guidelines

These guidelines explain how the Willowbank School logo should be used to help us achieve a common, consistent and recognisable brand for our school.

Our Logo

Our logo is an important part of our school identity and should be immediately identifiable to our community.

The logo is made up of two elements: the Kilmarnock Willow and the school name in both English and Gaelic.

Size and Clear Space

Minimum size

The minimum size of the logo should be 4cm in length.
Making the logo any smaller than this will make it difficult to read.



Clear space

There should always be a clear space around the logo that is free of any other text or graphics.





Variations

Main logo

This is the main logo and should be used in most cases.



Stacked logo

This is an alternative version that can be used if spacing is restricted or if the available space is more boxed.



Tree only

This can be used when the main logo is already used elsewhere, where space is really restricted and when the audience is already familiar with the logo, for example on folder labels, website icons or page headers as in show at the top of this page.



Pride Logo

A rainbow version of the logo is available for use during Pride events or for anything relating to LGBT+ matters.

Colours

Sometimes, colours will need to be adapted slightly to make the logo fit with the materials.

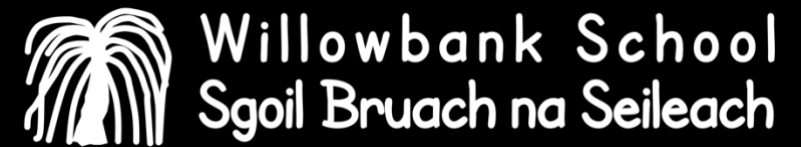
Examples of this include if there is a darker or lighter background that cannot be changed.
