2. Head Prefects	
DR welcomed the HP and invited them to give an overview of their role - HP role includes manage a group of 70 S6 prefects, supervise the first few weeks with S1, organise the timings for supervision at the doors at break and lunch, organise committees, speaking at assemblies and being involved in community meetings. School and HP's are happy with how things have been going in the first few weeks. DR emphasised the importance of the HP leadership role in the school and wider community.	
3. A report on the work of the Parent Council – Stephen Coyle	
During the last academic session, the parent council covered a wide range of topics and had a lot of input from various staff within the school. these included: DHT's areas of responsibility, exam results, well-being, inclusion and equality, Respect Me anti-bullying policy, employability and pupil destinations with real world examples, raising attainment, budget and cost of living/of the school day in connection with the wide range of support offered by the school, a session with Mr Hodge, Principal teacher for Maths, detailing his maths resources for different year groups, SQA results session and discussions regarding school bus provision

6. School Update

DR and AB are the SLT representation on parent council. DR gave an update on many areas including recognising pupil voice, UNCR charter, rights of the pupil, pupil leadership academy where decisions will be taken on school improvements

DR also outlined the support to pupils by the school, e.g. school drama trip costs met by PEF/other funding sources – and confirmed educational trips to be met by the school.

With regard to the pop up shop in August, DR confirmed it was fairly well attended, with school uniform or resources freely available to all. Also delivered resources to families who couldn't attend the school to pick. The mail drop which goes out over the summer will be electronic next year.

DR also gave a staffing update and detailed new staff, current vacancies and future plans for the session. He also confirmed the Standards and Quality Report and School Improvement Plan are on blog, thanked parent council for their input.

The SQA results session will come back later in the session when all data is back.

DR advised that SLT are currently ensuring that statutory responsibilities in respect of ASN pupils are being met. – checking on staff in respect of ASN and if staff know what pupil's requirements are. Review the data to ensure DR/SLT are happy DR also advised that:

- Satchel one update current review to ensure all staff are using, drive by digital committee.
- work has been ongoing to ensure senior phase have appropriate curriculum
- uniform standards have been great, reiterated thanks to parents.
- Fun run coming up forms to be handed in
- pupils can come in and pre order before school and at interval.

- DR confirmed it is very busy, will need to come back as this could be for multiple reasons
