The information below outlines the likelihood of achieving a Higher pass based on a C pass at National 5. This should be carefully considered when looking at progression from National 5 to Higher.

In the following subjects, progression from a 'C' at N5 to a pass at Higher is realistic for over 50\% of pupils, therefore if you achieved a C pass at N5 you might wish to consider picking these subjects at Higher

| PE | $65 \%$ of pupils achieving a C at N5 passed at Higher |

In the following subjects, progression from a 'C' at N5 to a pass at Higher is less likely with only 30-40\% of pupils achieving a C pass at N5 passing at Higher. We would not advise you pick these subjects at Higher if there are other subjects which you could pick with either an A or B at Higher or from the list above.

In the following subjects, progression from a ' C ' at N5 to a pass at Higher is very unlikely with less than 30\% of pupils achieving a C pass at N5 passing at Higher. We would not recommend you progress to Higher with a C pass in these subjects
