Old V's New

Old:

- ▶ Column structure
- ▶ Pick one subject from each column
- ▶ Restricted choice
- ▶ Cannot always pick your best subjects

New:

- ▶ Free choice
- ▶ Pick any 5 subjects that you studied in S4
- ▶ Less restricted choice
- ▶ Can pick your best subjects

With both systems classes only run if there are enough pupils pick a subject and there are enough teachers available. We will try our best to match your choices but this may not always be possible.

SCQF Framework

- ▶ This is the system across Scotland which makes sure all qualifications are rated against one framework, from National 1 all the way up to University level and also including apprenticeships
- ▶ Range of subjects available at different levels to meet the needs of all learners – National 3 to Advanced Higher

SCQF Framework – my choices?

In S4 you will study a range of subjects, usually at SCQF Level 3, 4 or 5

SCQF Level 3: These will usually be at National 3, there is no exam at this level.

SCQF Level 4: These will usually be at National 4, there is no exam at this level.

SCQF Level 5:

- ▶ National 5 (Graded A-D) – for example, English or History; these will usually have an external exam
- ▶ NPA Level 5 (Graded Pass or Fail) – for example Digital Media; these will have no external exam

What subjects should I pick?

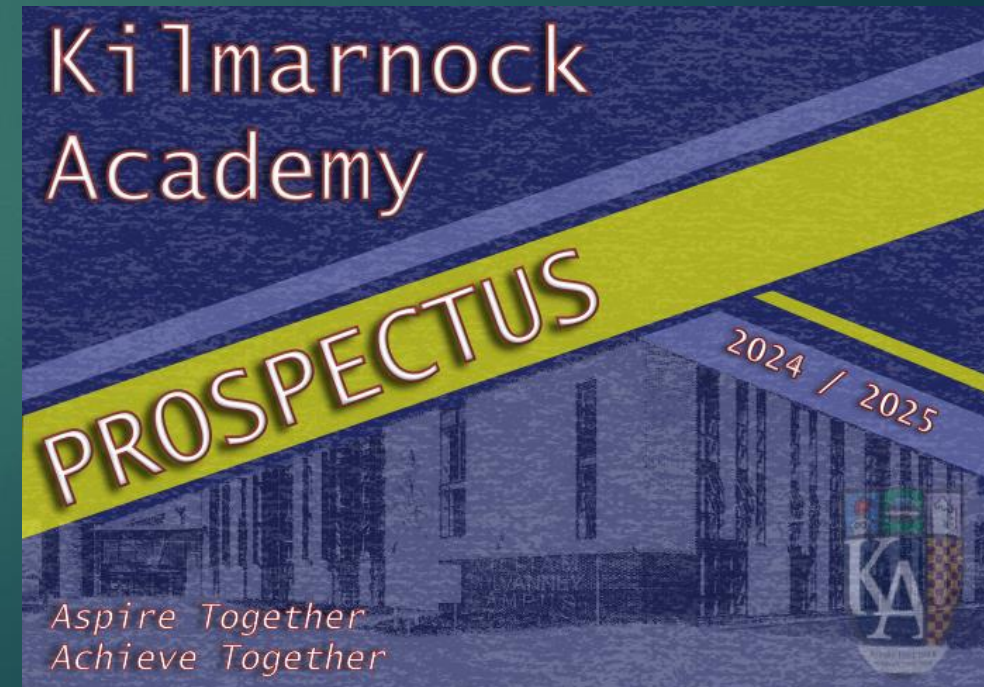
In S4 you must maximise your attainment, this means you should pick the subjects you are going to get the best qualifications in. This will give you the best chance of progression in S5 as you must continue with the subjects you picked in S4.

You should pick subjects in the following order

- ▶ Those subjects which you are predicted to achieve a National 5.
- ▶ Those subjects you are good at
- ▶ Those subjects you enjoy

Subjects

- ▶ You will study 7 subjects in total This includes English and Maths – you will then pick **5 other subjects**. This must be **subjects you are currently studying in S3**.

Week Beginning Monday 5th February – Options interviews start. You will have an individual meeting with your Pupil Support Teacher who will discuss the following:

- ▶ What you plan on doing when you leave school
- ▶ Your best 5 subjects
- ▶ The subjects we recommend you pick to maximise your attainment
- ▶ You will then complete together your pathways form and your PTPS will complete a spreadsheet with your choices recorded on it
- ▶ You will take your pathways form home to be signed by your parents/ carers

Friday 16th February – Deadline for returning Curriculum Pathways forms and S5 agreement.

If it is not returned by this date you may not get the options you have selected as your form will not be included in the computer program that is used in the next stage of the options process.
